

THE DAYMAR FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP SHOWCASE WINNER DETAILS

WINNER – Receives a tuition scholarship up to \$25,000 (four years at \$6,250 per year), at your choice of **ANY** accredited higher educational institution. This award goes toward tuition cost.

REQUIREMENTS OF THE WINNERS

1. A copy of your letter of acceptance to the college or university of your choice, and/or the appropriate information needed for the Daymar Foundation to issue your institutional choice a check toward your tuition cost.
2. The award is paid directly to the provider (educational institution) for the purpose of the award (tuition).
3. A copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) furnished by the US Department of Education.
4. The winner must have enrolled and scheduled to start in a selected field of study the semester following your high school graduation.
5. The winner must complete the credit load for a full time student as determined by your institutional choice.
6. The winner must maintain a 2.2 GPA each year of the award.
7. The winner must provide the Daymar Foundation with a copy of your transcript at the end of each year, to determine if the GPA is in good standing with this scholarship requirement.
8. The winner must refer to the www.daymarfoundation.org website for the Deferment Policy and Probation Policy for this award.
9. The winner must agree for their photo and name to be used in Daymar Foundation advertising and publications.
10. The winner must agree, if at all possible, to come back and participate in the 2011 Scholarship Showcase event by presenting to the 2011 winner.

RUNNER UP – Receives a \$500 books and fees scholarship for one semester/quarter. This award goes toward the cost of books and any institutional fees.

1. A copy of your letter of acceptance to the college or university of your choice, and/or the appropriate information needed for the Daymar Foundation to issue your institutional choice a check toward your books and/or fees.
2. The award is paid directly to the provider (educational institution) for the purpose of the award (books and fees) if at all possible. If this is not possible, the check will be sent to the winner for the purpose of the stated award.
3. A copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) furnished by the US Department of Education.
4. The winner must have enrolled and scheduled to start in a selected field of study the semester following your high school graduation.
5. The winner must complete the credit load for a full time student as determined by your institutional choice.
6. The winner must agree for their photo and name to be used in Daymar Foundation advertising and publications.

2nd RUNNER UP – Receives a \$250 award for one semester/quarter. This award is to be spent toward your college education.

1. A copy of your letter of acceptance to the college or university of your choice, and/or the appropriate information needed for the Daymar Foundation to issue your institutional choice a check.
2. The award is paid directly to the provider (educational institution) for the purpose of the award (toward the student's educational cost) if at all possible. If this is not possible, the check will be sent to the winner for the purpose of the stated award.
3. A copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) furnished by the US Department of Education.
4. The winner must have enrolled and scheduled to start in a selected field of study the semester following your high school graduation.
5. The winner must complete the credit load for a full time student as determined by your institutional choice.
6. The winner must agree for their photo and name to be used in Daymar Foundation advertising and publications.
